This includes- eliminating intolerance and unknown bias, modeling diversity, fostering conversations that educate, implementing more trainings on race and diversity, and creating an environment where all feel they are heard and understood.

It is more important than ever to take care of ourselves so that we can in turn care for and stand up for those whose voices must be heard. Take time to rest and reflect. Pathway is committed to positive growth and we are here to support you and your family.
