Numbers reflect Fiscal Year July 1, 2025 - June 30, 2026

Pathway's mission is to help children and families to realize the possibilities of their lives through foster care, adoption and mental health services.

- Since 1973, supporters like you have made Pathway's work possible. In FY26, **1,796 children and families** in 14 Northeast Ohio counties felt safer, strengthened relationships, and built skills for the future.
- **85 children** found safety, care, and belonging in Pathway foster homes
- **9 children** found permanent families through adoption by Pathway foster families.
- **51 young adults** in the Bridges Program received coaching, housing support, and life-skills training so they could step confidently into independence after foster care.
- **966 students in 9 schools** received support within reach. Pathway therapists and case managers are there when students need them, helping them navigate challenges and build resilience.
- **92 volunteers** gave **736 hours** of time—planning events, serving on the board and associate board, assisting with projects, and reminding children that they are valued and loved.
- **38 teens** experienced healing and connection at TRUST Camp in July, a safe space where youth discover friendship, confidence, and self-worth.
- **966 children and families** received **27,851 mental health services** including counseling, group support, Family Empowerment, and case management resources.
- **764 children and teens** participated in prevention programs that reduce the risk of future mental health and substance abuse challenges and strengthen resilience.
